RE: Caldwell County Appraisal District Delinquent Tax Collection Report – Third Quarter 2017 – 2018 (January - March)

Dear Board of Directors:

Attached, please find our quarterly report regarding our delinquent tax collection efforts on behalf of the Caldwell County taxing jurisdictions for which we represent. During this quarter we collected a total of \$536,259 in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest.

Delinquent Tax Collection Report

Here is a summary of the specific delinquent tax collection steps we have undertaken during the third quarter of the 2017 - 2018 tax year and the results of those actions.

New Lawsuits – We filed 28 new lawsuits involving 35 properties. These suits sought the enforcement of \$97,367 in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest.

Suit Dismissal – During this quarter we prepared and submitted notices of non-suits in 7 suits involving 10 property accounts and \$125,695 in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest. A non-suit is filed once all taxes in a given suit have been paid.

-Judgments – During this quarter we obtained 6 judgments involving 8 different properties. These judgments sought the enforcement of \$103,440 in delinquent taxes, penalty and interest.

Tax Sales – During this reporting period we held one regular tax sale which included 9 cases involving 12 property accounts. As a direct result of this sale, there was a total revenue collected of \$125,000 in delinquent taxes, penalties and fees. During this quarter we also sold one struck-off property which resulted in a direct revenue of \$5,020 in delinquent taxes, penalties and fees.

Excess Proceeds — During this quarter we disbursed excess proceeds from 3 cases. As a

direct result of this disbursement, there was a total revenue collected of \$18,124 in delinquent taxes, penalties and fees.

Mass Mailing – During the third quarter of the collection year we mailed an individualized demand letter to every delinquent taxpayer reminding them of their obligation to the various taxing jurisdictions and encouraging them to submit payment of their delinquent taxes.

Thank you for this opportunity to report to you concerning our activities on behalf of the taxing jurisdictions of Caldwell County that we represent. We will continue to provide this Board as much in depth reporting as desired for those jurisdictions that we do represent. Should there be any questions concerning our efforts or any other matter related to ad valorem taxation, please do not hesitate to contact this office.

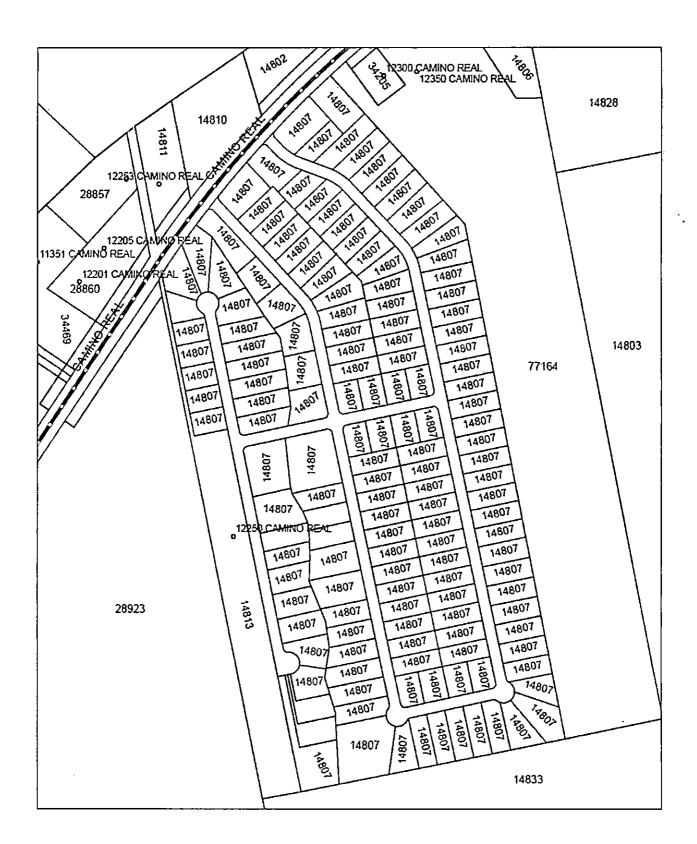

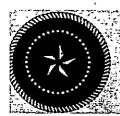

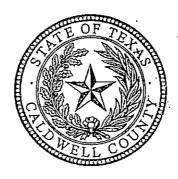
