RE: Caldwell County Appraisal District Delinquent Tax Collection Report

Dear Mr. Munoz:

Attached, please find our quarterly report regarding our delinquent tax collection efforts on behalf of the Caldwell County taxing jurisdictions that we represent. During this quarter, we collected a total of **\$1,697,538** in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest.

Delinquent Tax Collection Report

Here is a summary of the specific delinquent tax collection steps we have undertaken during the first quarter of the 2025-2026 tax year and the results of those actions.

New Lawsuits – During this quarter, we filed **16 new lawsuits** involving **23** properties. These suits sought the enforcement of **\$382,385** in delinquent taxes, penalty and interest.

Suit Dismissal – During this quarter, we prepared and submitted notices of **non-suit in 10 suits** involving **19 property** accounts and **\$209,073** in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest. A non-suit is filed once all taxes in a given suit have been paid.

Judgments – During this quarter, we held two regular trial settings. We obtained **10 judgments** involving **14** properties. These judgments sought the enforcement of **\$88,522** in delinquent taxes, penalty and interest. The original number of cases set was 15 cases involving 21 properties. A total of 5 cases and 7 properties were pulled for payment. These payments resulted in an immediate collection of \$35,919 in delinquent taxes, penalties and interest.

Tax Sales – During this quarter, we did not have a tax sale.

Excess Proceeds – During this quarter, we not disburse any excess proceeds.

Mass Mailing – During the first quarter of the collection year we conducted 2 mailings, of which, we mailed an individual demand letter to every taxpayer reminding them of their obligation to the various taxing jurisdictions and encouraging them to submit payment of their delinquent taxes.

Tax Warrants – During this quarter, we did not file any tax warrants.

Interventions – During this quarter, we filed 5 new interventions involving 5 properties. These interventions sought the enforcement of \$40,828 in delinquent taxes, penalty and interest.

CALL TO ORDER at 5:01 PM.

Pledges of Allegiance were recited.

Item #1. Public Comments.

There were no public comments.

Item #2. Collection Report July and August 2025.

Shanna Ramzinski presented the Collections reports for July 2025 and August 2025.

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Board did deliver a written copy of the resolution in accordance with section 6.06 (c) of the Texas Tax Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board hereby amends the 2024 and 2025 appraisal budgets by retaining excess 2024 funds in the amount of \$90,000 and transferring those funds in the amount of \$40,000 to the District’s 2025 emergency reserve fund and \$50,000 to legal services.
